*Tenderers will be evaluated on functionality whereby point will be allocated as follows: Project proposal – 40 points, Bidders experience- 30 points and Experience of key staff- 30 points. The bidder is expected to attain 60 points in order financial proposal can be looked at. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of BBBEE status. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.*

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity

- **Company Registration Certificate**
- **Certified Copy of B-BBEE certificate (non compulsory, failure to submit no points will be awarded)**
