Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Steve Tshwete Municipality at the Committee Room of the Executive Manager Technical Facilities on 15/08/2012 starting at 10H00.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12H00, Thursday on 23/08/2012**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "TENDER NO. BS02/08/2012 : APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR ESTABLISHING A TOWNSHIP TO BE KNOWN AS NEWTOWN EXTENSION " with the name of the Tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before 12H00 on the closing date. The tenders will be opened in public.

Bids will be pre-qualified in accordance with functionality criteria as outlined in the tender. Only the bids that meet the minimum number of points out of the total number of points for functionality will proceed to the price and preference goals evaluation stage.

Technical queries may be directed to the Meshack Mahamba. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, electronic and late tenders will not be accepted.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 90 points will be allocated in respect of price and 10 points in respect B-BBEE Status level of contribution Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work .Documents to that need to be submitted with the bid:

- *Company Registration Documents*
- *Original Valid Tax Clearance Certificate*
- *Valid Certified copies of BBBEE status Certificate (Not compulsory but failure to submit no points will be awarded for BBBEE status)*

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person , of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity
