BS06/04/2013: Operations and maintenance of the waste transfer stations and garden waste facilities in Komati, Hendrina and waste transfer station only at Rietkuil**" with the name of the Tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before **12:00** on the closing date. The tenders will be opened in public.

Bids will be pre-qualified in accordance with functionality criteria as outlined in the tender. Only the bids that meet the minimum number of points out of the total number of points for functionality will proceed to the price and preference goals evaluation stage.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status level of contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

Company Registration documents
Proof of ownership or rental agreement of Resources/Plant
BBBEE certificate (non compulsory) failure to submit will result in 0 points scored for that target goal.
