ELECTRIFICATION OF ROCKDALE (PHASE 2)

Tenders are hereby invited for the construction of THE ELECTRIFICATION OF ROCKDALE (PHASE 2) in the Steve Tshwete Municipal region. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 4EP or 3EPPE or higher.** The contract comprises mainly of

- The complete supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of the electrical installation for 286 stands in compliance with the requirements of this document.
- The supply, delivery and installation of 11kV, Overhead Bundle Conductor on 11m wooden poles to supply the Pump station on the boundary of Rockdale.
- The supply, delivery and installation of a 16mm² x 4 core SWA\PVC cable to the existing High Mast Structure
- The removal and dismantling of the Temporary supply of the high mast structure.
- The complete contract management of the contract.

Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "**TENDER NO. BS09/12/2011: ELECTRIFICATION OF ROCKDALE (PHASE 2)**" with the name of the Tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before **12:00** on the closing date. The tenders will be opened in public.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Boardroom Manager Technical and Facilities on 11 January 2012 starting at 9:30 hrs. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the Engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

Bids will be pre-qualified in accordance with functionality criteria as outlined in the tender. Only the bids that meet the minimum number of points out of the total number of points for functionality will proceed to the price and preference goals evaluation stage.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2011 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 90 points will be allocated in respect of price and 10 points in respect of targeted goals. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
