*Bidders will be evaluated on functionality whereby have to attained 60 points for the financial proposal to be looked at. The functionality points will be allocated as follows: Quality of product-40, Compliance with the Employer's technical equipments – 40, Training - 20. A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE status level of contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.*

Contractors who have the following are eligible to tender and must provide such proof:

- Original Valid Tax Clearance Certificate
- Company Registration Certificate
- Certified valid B-BBEE certificate (non compulsory failure to submit no points will be awarded)

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state.
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The Council is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender.
