A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Steve Tshwete Municipality Mechanical Workshop Boardroom at the Services Centre on 04 December 2012 starting at 09:00 hrs.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00 hrs on 13 December 2012**.

Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked **"TENDER NO. The tenders will be opened in public.

Accredited dealers who have the following are eligible to tender and must provide such proof

- Original Valid Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Company Registration Certificate.
- Certified copy of B-BBEE Certificate. (None compulsory document if not attached you will receive no points in respect of *B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution*)
- **Valid accreditation certificate as an accredited motor vehicle dealer.**

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity
