UPGRADING OF VAALBANK WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Tenders are hereby invited for the construction of Vaalbank Water Treatment Plant Upgrade in the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality region. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 6CE or higher.** The contract comprises mainly of two additional Rapid Gravity filters, a new division box and interconnecting pipes.

Only bank guaranteed cheques or cash will be accepted. Cheques shall be made payable to the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Vaalbank Water Works on 11 December 2012 starting at 10:00 hrs.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12H00, 21 December 2012**.

Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "**TENDER NO. BS12.11.2012: UPGRADING OF VAALBANK WATER TREATMENT PLANT**" with the name of the Tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before **12H00** on the closing date. The tenders will be opened in public.

Tenders will be evaluated on the basis of price.

The following documents should be included:

- Original Valid Tax Clearance Certificate
- Company Registration Certificate
- Original/certified copy of BBBEE Certificate (non compulsory failure to submit no points will be allocated)

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 90 points will be allocated in respect of price and 10 points in respect of targeted goals. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity

The Council is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender.
